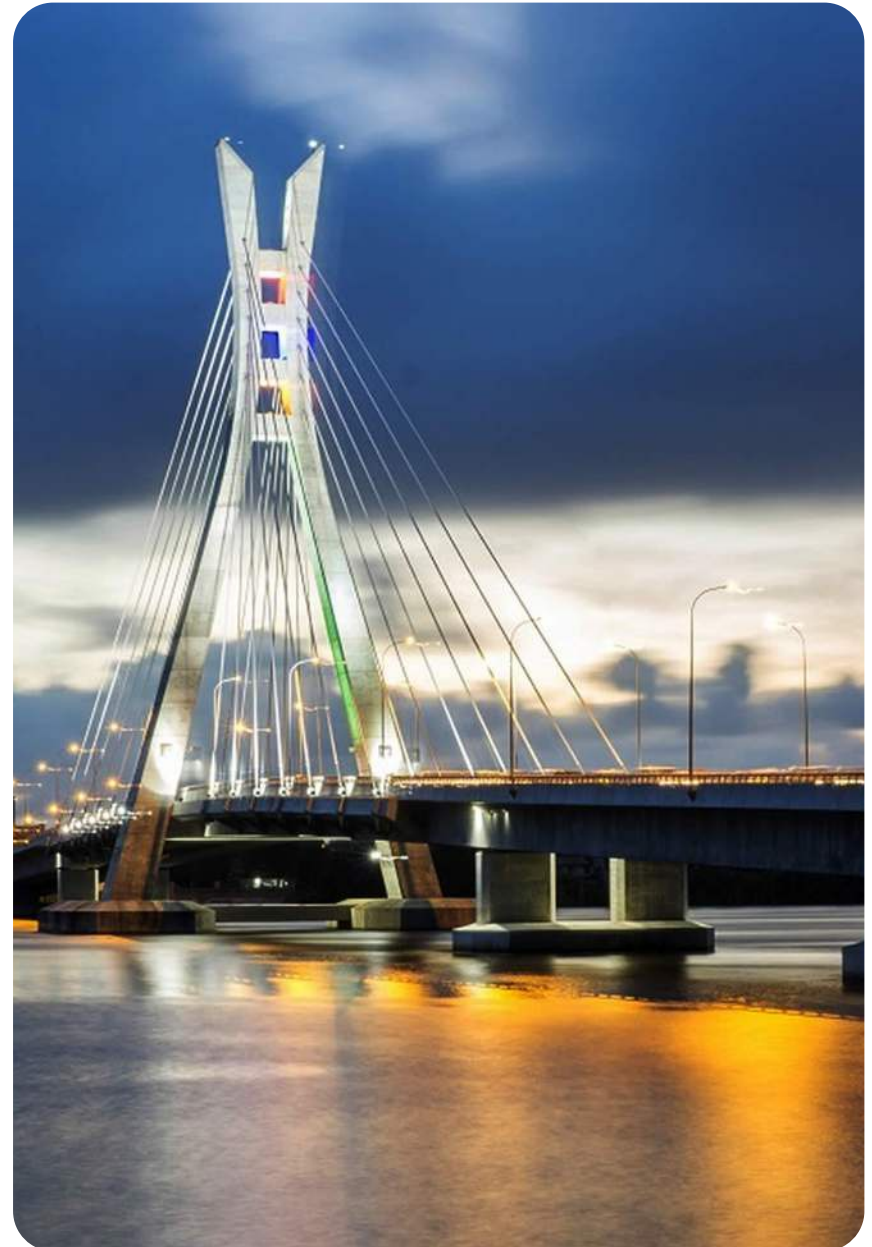


# Welcome to Lagos!

---

# Travel & Entry Requirements

---



## Visa Information

- Visitors may require a visa to come into Nigeria, arrangements are being made to provide delegates with Visa- on – arrival for countries that are eligible.
- Please check the conference registration **webpage** for country eligibility and specific requirements.
- Ensure your passport is valid for at least six months beyond your stay.

## Health Guidelines

- Yellow Fever vaccination is required for all travelers entering Nigeria.
- Travel health insurance is recommended
- Make sure to declare your health status using the **NCDC Health Declaration Form**

## Custom Check

- Items such as firearms, certain food and certain medications are prohibited.
- Any cash exceeding USD 10,000 should be declared.

# Getting Your Visa-on-Arrival

---

- **Step 1: Check Eligibility**

Most delegates can get a Visa on Arrival, but just to be sure, check the Nigerian immigration website or ask your local Nigerian embassy.

- **Step 2: Apply Online**

Apply for pre-approval through the **official Nigerian visa portal**. After application, you'll get a Reference Code and Application ID.

During your application, you'll need to upload a few documents:

- ✚ A valid passport (at least 6 months before expiry)
- ✚ Flight itinerary
- ✚ A letter of self-introduction
- ✚ A visa invitation letter from the host/s - **we can provide this**
- ✚ A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation (the host/s) - **we can provide**
- ✚ A copy of the passport data page of the signatory of the invitation letter - **we can provide this**

# Getting Your Visa-on-Arrival

---

- **Step 3: Pay the Visa Fee**

Visit this document - [VISA FEE](#) to check the visa fee for your country. Remember to save your payment receipt.

- **Step 4: Send Us Your Details**

After applying, send us your **Reference Code** and **Application ID** [nokereke@cscs.ng](mailto:nokereke@cscs.ng) or fill it out on the [conference registration form](#).

- **Step 5: Arriving In Lagos**

When you land, head straight to the Visa on Arrival desk at the airport. To make your entry even smoother, make sure to have these documents:

- Your Reference Code and Application ID
- Proof of visa fee payment
- Your yellow fever vaccination card
- Your health declaration form - [Health Declaration Form](#)
- Your hotel booking confirmation

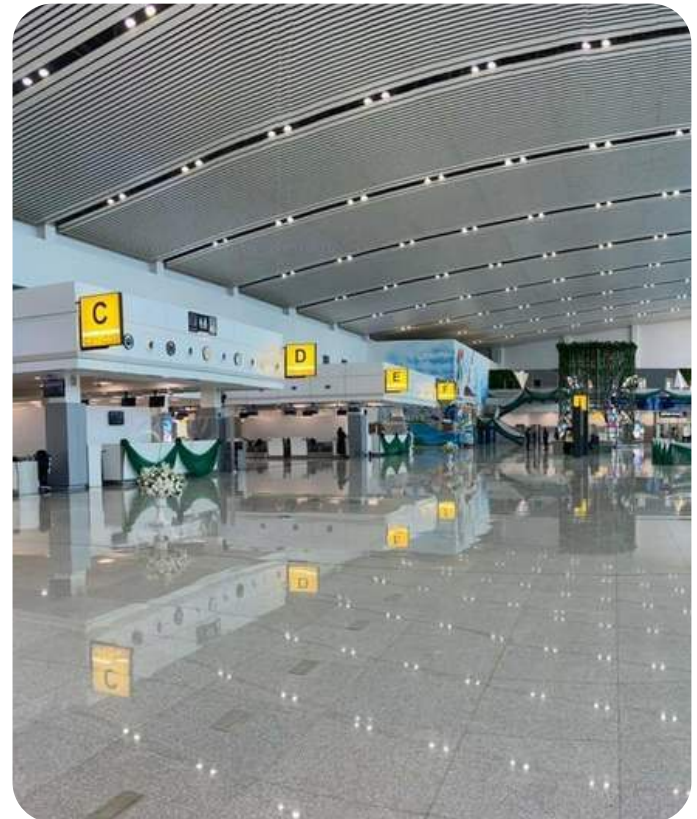

# Arrival In Lagos

---

- Most international delegates will arrive via Murtala Muhammed International Airport (LOS), Lagos.
- Customs and Immigration Clearance is expected to take 20 – 30 minutes
- An arrival lounge will be provided to sit guests before movement to their respective hotel.
- Airport facilities include Bureau de Change (currency exchange), SIM card vendors, and taxi services.
- A complimentary airport pick-up will be provided for the delegates on arrival at the airport to recommended hotels

# Currency & Payment

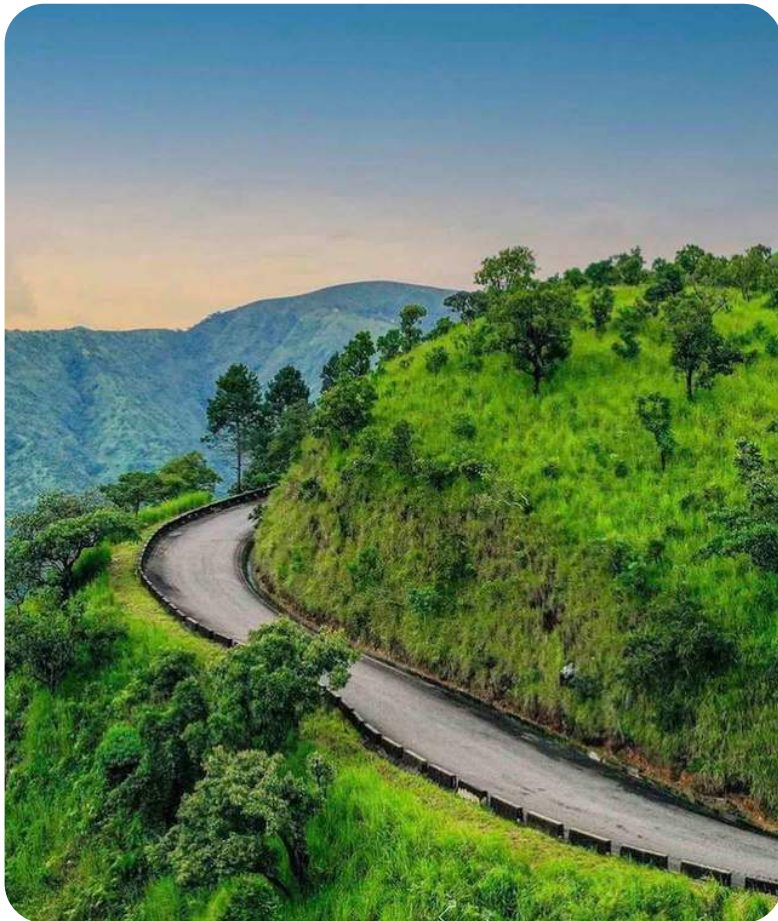

- The local currency is the Nigerian Naira (NGN), Bureau de Change operators are available at the airport facility.
- Major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Verve) are accepted at all locations.
- Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) are widely available. Please ensure your bank debit cards work internationally.



# Weather & Dress Code

---



- Lagos forecasts warm and humid temperatures ranging between **26°C – 33°C (79°F – 91°F)**, from the 23rd to 25th April 2025.
- Occasional rainfall is expected as April is part of the early rainy season.
- Carry a light rain jacket or umbrella as this may be useful for sudden showers.
- Business casual or formal attire is appropriate for the conference.
- **Light, breathable clothing** is recommended for comfort.
